Dear Families,

We know that London is currently designated as a 'TIER 2' zone and has associated restrictions. However, we have been given a different set of tiers specifically for education. Currently, we are at Education Tier 1. Below are the plans for Walworth Academy, should we need to move between Education Tiers but we will confirm any such changes for families as soon as we are informed of them ourselves.

TIER 0 – School open with COVID measures

↳ All students attend school ↳ All staff attend school

ISOLATING STUDENTS

- *If anyone in a household has symptoms all must self isolate from school.*
- *Students take work packs home/work is sent*
- *FSM care packages are provided where appropriate*
- *Students complete Homework on SMHW*

TIER 1 – School open with additional measures *****[CURRENT STATUS]*****

↳ All students attend school ↳ All staff attend school

ISOLATING STUDENTS

- *If anyone in a household has symptoms all must self isolate from school.*
- *Students take work packs home/work is sent*
- *FSM care packages are provided where appropriate*
- *Students complete Homework on SMHW*

- **All staff, students & visitors wear face coverings in transition areas.**
- **Student exemptions are notified by parents, in writing, to the DOP who will provide a note.**

TIER 2 – School open on a rota

↳ All staff attend school

↳ Key Worker & vulnerable student provision to open. Students join their classes when in, and are in school completing remote tasks when 'out'

Y7 & Y8

- One week in/ One week out
- Staff deliver lessons to those in school & set remote tasks by pack & SMHW for those out
- DOP/ICO call those out of school
- FSM vouchers for those out of school

Y9 & Y10

- One week in/ One week out
- Staff deliver lessons to those in school & set remote tasks by pack & SMHW for those out
- DOP/ICO call those out of school
- FSM vouchers for those out of school

Y11

- In school at all times
- Teaching to normal timetable
- Single lunch period

Y12

- One week in/ One week out
- Staff deliver lessons via MSTeams for those out of school
- 6th form leadership to call those out of school
- FSM vouchers for those out of school

Y13

- In school at all times
- Teaching to normal timetable
- Single lunch period

NOTE: school will attempt to ensure siblings are in and out of school on the same rota.

TIER 3 – Partial closure determined by the Government

↳ All staff attend school ↳ Key Worker & vulnerable student provision on site.

Department for Education to advise on year groups to attend school

Remote provision via SMHW & paper packs for Y7-10

Remote provision via MSTeams for Y11, Y12 & Y13

Remote pastoral service for all years out of school

FSM vouchers for all students out of school

TIER 4 – Enforced school closure

↳ Key Worker & vulnerable student provision on site.

↳ Staff DO NOT attend school except those supporting key worker provision

Y7-10

- SMHW & paper packs used to provide work
- FSM vouchers issued
- Pastoral calls made remotely

Y11

- lessons daily on MSTeams
- Morning Sessions (4 lessons - Eng, Ma, Sci, option Mon-Thurs/ Option x 4 Fri)
- FSM vouchers issued
- Pastoral calls made remotely

Y12&13

- lessons daily on MSTeams
- Afternoon sessions (3 lessons)
- FSM vouchers issued
- Pastoral calls made remotely
